Shochikubai 'Mio' – Sparkling Sake (Hyogo, Japan)	
Refreshing, delicate and fruity with moderate acidity and a hint of vanilla and blackberry. Delicious as an aperitif.	13
Shichiken – Junmai (Yamanishi, Japan)	
Soft, round and flavoursome with aromas of ripe melon and citrus. Great purity, elegance and depth of flavour. Great with tempura.	15/78
Kamoizumi Shusen 'Three Dots' – Junmai (Hiroshima, Japan)	
Savoury style sake that is big and bold with notes of mushrooms and a lovely autumnal character. Perfect for meatier yakitori cuts and beef.	16/104 (900ml)
Shichiken – Junmai Ginjo (Yamanishi, Japan)	
Smooth, off-dry, with medium body. Pineapple notes leading to a hint of umami and a crisp finish. Works particularly well with oily fish.	17/88

A soft and fragrant sake with great precision and freshness, floral notes with hints of pear and melon on the long, bright finish. Excellent with shellfish.	18/93
