<b>Terre di Rai Prosecco Extra Dry (Veneto, Italy)</b> Glera. Peach, grapefruit and jasmine. A soft and full-bodied Prosecco. The perfect aperitif.	34 / 8*
<b>Léo Charruau Bullula Pet Nat Rosé (Loire, France)</b> Cabernet Franc. Blood orange, pomegranate, and pink grapefruit. A precise and refined, organic, pet-nat from a young, rising star from the Loire.	44
<b>Langham Culver Classic Cuvee (Dorset, England)</b> Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier. Cranberry, cherry and apple blossom. Rich, world-class sparkling wine from a young and accomplished winemaker Tommy Grimshaw.	68 / 13*
<b>Charles Heidsieck Brut Resrve</b> Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Meunier. Apricot, greengages and toasted almonds. Long aged for complexity in the deep chalk cellars of the smallest and most admired Grand Marques.	98

<b>Familia Castaño Organic Macabeo (Murcia, Spain)</b> Macabeo. Quince, apple and pear. A smooth and refreshing organically made Macabeo grown high up on the sundrenched hills of Yecla.	30
<b>Azevedo Vinho Verde (Vinho Verde, Portugal)</b> Loureiro, Alvarinho. Vibrant lime, nectarine and mango. A tropical and refreshing white made with sustainable farming on an ancient wine estate.	34 / 7*
<b>Domaine Saint Louis Sauvignon Blanc (Pays d'Oc, France)</b> Sauvignon Blanc. Zesty pomelo, passion fruit and bright elderflower. A pure Sauvignon blanc made on an organic farm practising agroforestry.	38 / 8*
<b>Gallina de Piel Ikigall (Galicia, Spain)</b> Xarel-lo, Malvasia de Sitges, Muscat. Peach, dried mandarine and fennel. Produced using old organic vines from the itinerant winemaking project of El Bulli's ex-head of wine, David Seijas.	44 / 9*
<b>Matic Postopoma - Orange Wine (Stajerska, Slovenia)</b> Kerner, Riesling. Rich baked apples, wildflowers and apricots. This orange wine is a field blend grown with biodynamic principles made by a winemaking prodigy.	48
<b>A&amp;D Singular (Baião, Portugal)</b> Alvarinho, Avesso, Arinto, Malvasia Fina. Ripe pear, lychee and saline. A richer style of Vinho Verde that is handmade from a tiny organic vineyard.	51
<b>Dorper Chenin Blanc (Stellenbosch, South Africa)</b> Chenin Blanc. Melon, fresh green apple and straw. South African Chenin blanc at its very best made by sage hands from sustainable vineyards.	64 / 12*
<b>Troupe X Martin Diwald Welcome to the Jungle (Wagram, Austria)</b> Sauvignon Blanc, Grüner Veltliner, Riesling. Peach iced tea, ripe pear and smoky poblano chilli. A remarkable one-off wine from Martin Diwald's progressive biodynamic farm.	79 / 15*
<b>Domaine des Carlines En Beaumont (Jura, France)</b> Savagnin. White peach, lemon and flint smoke. A powerful yet balanced wine born from organic vineyards in Jura's unofficial grand cru, Château-Chalon.	90
<b>Donnafugata Sul Vulcano (Sicily, Italy)</b> Carricante. Mandarin, flint smoke and hay. A complex and mineral wine produced high up on Mount Etna as an ode to its goddess.	94
<b>Saint Aubin 'Le Charmois' Premier Cru (Burgundy, France)</b> Chardonnay. Lemon zest, rich, buttery and toasty. A concentrated Chardonnay farmed biodynamically and made in the cellars of Château de Chassagne-Montrachet.	120



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<b>Rose</b>	
<b>Domaine de Castelnaud Garenne Rosé (Languedoc, France)</b>	33 / 7*
Cinsault, Syrah. Wild strawberry, grapefruit and lemon zest. Sustainably made by an ex-melon farmer on land predominated by rabbits, Mediterranean sea breezes and grape vines.	
<b>Clos Venturi 1769 Rosé (Corsica, France)</b>	58
Sciaccarellu. Blood orange, strawberry and rose petals. This light and fresh wine is biodynamically farmed from vineyards that are worked by horses as opposed to machines.	
<b>Red</b>	
<b>Château Haut-Blanville Merlot (Pays d'Oc, France)</b>	30
Merlot. Strawberry, violets and sweet spices. A supple style of Merlot that is sustainably made near the ancient city of Montpellier.	
<b>Altos Las Hormigas Colonia Las Liebres (Mendoza, Argentina)</b>	35 / 7*
Bonarda. Plum, pink pepper and eucalyptus. Grown organically high above the Mendocian desert where the ants rule supreme.	
<b>Mandarossa Frappato (Sicily, Italy)</b>	38 / 8*
Frappato. Pomegranate, black cherry and star anise. A fresh and light, sustainably made red from Sicily's indigenous Frappato grape variety.	
<b>Casa Los Frailes Monastrell (Valencia, Spain)</b>	44
Monastrell. Velvety dark cherry, intense blackcurrant and roses. A sleek and perfumed biodynamic wine, made and aged in these ancient 18th-century stone tanks.	
<b>Léo Charruau Bois Pivain (Saumur-Champigny, France)</b>	48
Cabernet Franc. Raspberries, violets and toast. A delicate Cabernet franc made by a father-and-son collaboration from organic vineyards littered with wildflowers.	
<b>Domaine La Croix Gratiot Les Zazous (Pays d'Hérault, France)</b>	56 / 11*
Pinot noir. Cherries, prunes and cinnamon. A lively, silky and deep organic Pinot noir with all the stylings of its Mediterranean upbringing.	
<b>G.D. Vajra Claré J.C. (Langhe, Italy)</b>	63 / 12*
Nebbiolo. Vibrant redcurrants, cranberries and spicy liquorice. This most elegant and fresh style of organic Nebbiolo is made from an ancient family recipe.	
<b>Quinta de Santiago x Mira Do O SOU Dissidente (Portugal)</b>	74 / 14*
Alaverlhao (90%), Pedral, Borracal, Cainho, Alvarinho. Lush red cherry, dried herbs and balsamic. A fresh and elegant, rock and roll inspired collaboration wine made from forgotten grape varieties.	
<b>Nocturne Yallingup Cabernet Sauvignon (Western Australia, Australia)</b>	82
Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Malbec. Rich blackcurrant, plum and warming spice. A decadent and visionary Bordeaux blend from Maragret River made with minimal intervention.	
<b>Racines Santa Rita Hills Pinot Noir (California, USA)</b>	120
Pinot noir. Punchy dark cherry, sage and dark chocolate. A savoury Pinot noir born of high-calibre vineyards and made by high-calibre international winemakers.
